Policy Point 4: Extreme haircuts

4.1 The school does not permit children to have haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. Hairstyles should be appropriate for school. Extreme hairstyles, including markings in hair, shaved heads or extreme hair colour are not permitted. Pupils may be sent home in order to make their hairstyle acceptable.
