Music Tuition Fees

Please note that any lessons missed between February half term and Easter will be made up by your child's music teacher.

Music fees for the next half term are now due.

During the term there will be 6 lessons for the guitar and violin at a cost of £31.20 (£5.25 per lesson) or £22.50 for Year 5 Wider Opportunity pupils.

Piano, keyboard and brass students will have 5 lessons at a cost of £26.25 or £18.75 for Year 5 Wider Opportunity pupils.

Woodwind, voice, oboe and drum students will receive 4 lessons at a cost of £21.00 and £15.00 for Year 5 Wider Opportunity pupils.

All music lessons must be paid for in advance and cheques should be made payable to WMBC St Luke's School.

Please note that if your child is in Year 5 and plays two instruments the reduced fees are for their first instrument only.
