Operation Christmas Child

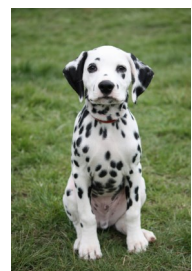
The children have brought home an Operation Christmas Child leaflet today.
