Operation Christmas Child

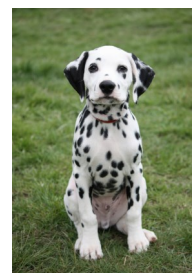
The children brought home an Operation Christmas Child leaflet last week.
