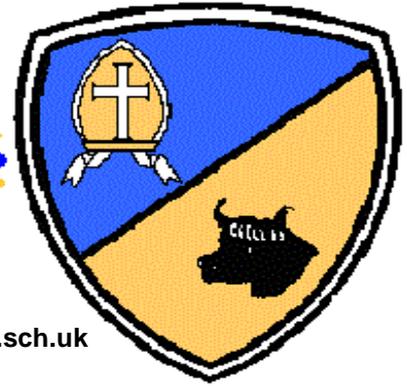


ST. LUKE'S CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to everyone who completed a questionnaire about your views of St. Luke's. This is the fourth time we have done this using the questions from the OFSTED Parent View. We really appreciate you taking the time to complete them and it has been extremely useful. It is something which we will continue to do annually as we value your feedback.

In total, we had thirty six replies and the feedback was extremely positive.

It was pleasing that the vast majority of parents who sent the questionnaire back felt strongly that their child or children are happy at school; are making good progress; are taught well; feel safe; needs are met; the school is well led and managed and that the school makes sure that their pupils are well-behaved. It is also pleasing to see that all of you would recommend our school to other parents.

We also received positive comments such as:

- 'Amazing support'
- 'Concerns dealt with rapidly'
- 'Kept informed'
- 'Like DOJO for behaviour'
- 'Nurturing school'
- 'Reassured if ever we have to contact school'
- 'We have no concerns'
- 'Very happy with all aspects of school'
- 'Children are very happy'
- 'Care, attention and challenge'

A few parents expressed that homework can take a while. As a result we will be holding a consultation on homework during the autumn term. One parent remarked that they only find out about their child's progress at Parent Consultation Evenings. There are two Parent Consultation Evenings, a

progress report is sent home at the end of the Autumn Term and you also receive an End of Year Report. However, we operate an open door policy and you can arrange a time to speak to the class teacher should you need to have an update on your child's progress.

I would like to take this opportunity to encourage you all to visit OFSTED's website and complete the online Parent View questionnaire. This will enable OFSTED to engage in your views of our school as it is possible that the school may be inspected at any time. This helps us to make sure that the relevant staff are available as sometimes staff are running extra curricular clubs, are on training courses or attending a staff meeting and alternative arrangements may need to be made.
