Advice can be obtained from your GP, local Pharmacy or School Nurse.

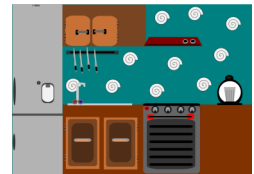


Knitting Wool
