We would also like to welcome Mrs Eckersley to St Luke's, Mrs Eckersley will be teaching in Reception class.



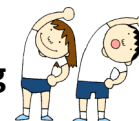
Safeguarding

Music Fees

Music fees are now due for the next half term. There will be 5 lessons during the term (3 for woodwind, drums, oboe and voice) at a cost of £26.25 and £15.75 for the pupils only receiving 3 lessons. Pupils in Year 5 accessing Wider Opportunities will pay £18.75 for 5 lessons and £11.25 for 3 lessons.

Please note that if your child is in Year 5 and accesses more than one music lesson the reduced fee only applies to one instrument.
