## Church Spring Fayre

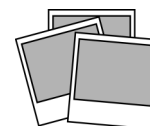
Thank you to everyone who sent in toys for the Spring Fayre. The Fayre was well attended and around £2000 was raised for Church funds.

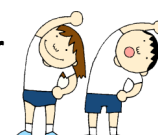
## Safeguarding

### Music Fees

Music fees are now due for this next half term. There will be 5 lessons during the term (3 for woodwind, drums, oboe and voice) at a cost of £26.25 and £15.75 for the pupils only receiving 3 lessons. Pupils in Year 5 accessing Wider Opportunities will pay £18.75 for 5 lessons and £11.25 for 3 lessons.



Please note that if your child is in Year 5 and accesses more than one music lesson the reduced fee only applies to one instrument.

All lessons missed due to school trips or teacher absence will be made up so please do not reduce your payment.

## Miss Parry's Window

**On the 4th December 2007, a stained glass window, bought by Miss Gill Parry was dedicated to school.**

**Miss Parry bought the window to commemorate her 33 years of teaching at St Luke's School.**

**The window was placed in the main school entrance doors, in order that it could be viewed by everyone arriving at school. The first line from our Mission Statement is etched below the stained glass cross and is a reminder to us all of how we strive to live our lives at St Luke's. As you will be aware, we have replaced our old door entry system with a modern sliding door. In doing so Miss Parry's window needed to be removed.**

**Fortunately, the builders who have been working in school have managed to skilfully remove the window from the old doors. It has now been reframed and mounted in our entrance hall. We are delighted that here it can still be viewed by anyone entering school and our staff and pupils during the school day.**
