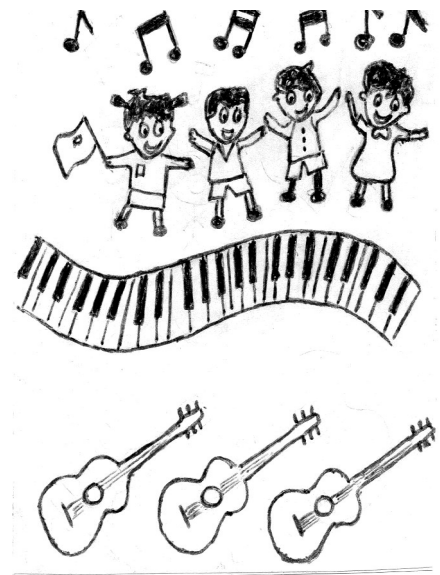
ON SUNDAY 28th April, 2019 AT 10.30 A.M.
