Lessons are available to pay on Lunch Shop. We are trialling a new arrangement on Lunch Shop, where you should only be able to see the music lesson options that apply to your child.

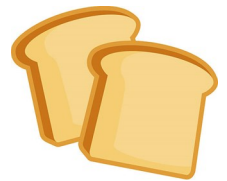
