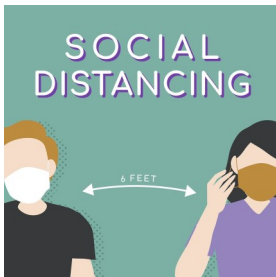

Hospital/Doctors/Dentist/Optician Appointments

In this situation we ask that the class teacher is informed in advance and the office telephoned in order that your child will be waiting for you when you arrive at school.

Important Information Regarding Illness

If your child is off school due to illness, please telephone the school office on the first day of absence and leave a message on the answer phone. When your child returns to school please email the school office with an absence explanation for our official files. Please avoid sending paper letters into school.

Please keep your child off school for 48 hours if they are absent from school with a stomach ache – regardless of whether they have experienced sickness or diarrhoea.
