We regularly send messages and updates including the weekly School Newsletter via our text messaging service 'Teachers2Parents'.

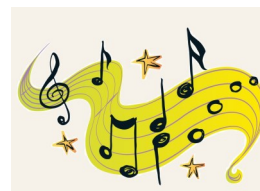
We have been informed that a number of parents are not receiving the messages that are sent out. If you know of anyone in this situation could you please advise them not to use Teachers2 Parents through the App.
