The aim of the workshops is to demonstrate how children are expected to tackle the four basic mathematic operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

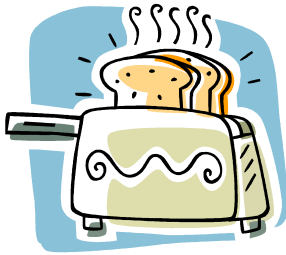


This will give parents the opportunity to see how our new VCP (maths visual calculations policy) is used to support the daily teaching and learning of maths in school.

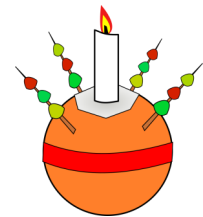
Christingle Service
