Weather permitting Sports Day will take place on Wednesday 5th July.

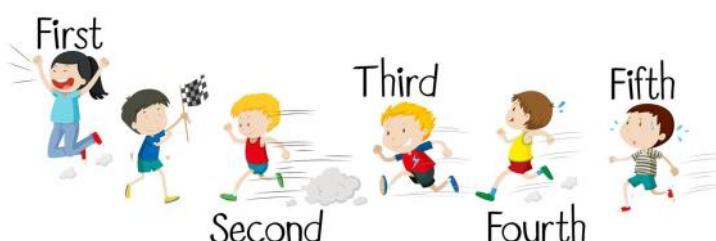
Infant events will take place on the school field after registration. Parents, grandparents and carers are welcome to watch the events and will be able to access the school field after dropping their children at school.
