Please note that the before and after school club office is open in a morning between 7.30 — 9.00am and between 2.30 — 6.00pm in an afternoon.

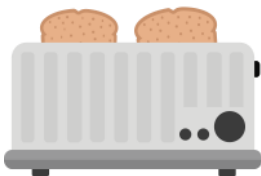
