### **Italian Themed School Dinner Thursday 16th May**

Each year our school receives a grant to cover the provision of infant free school meals. The funding is based on the number of infant children who take a school meal on census days, which take place in January, May and October.

This year our funding has decreased by approximately £5,000 because the number of children taking a meal on census days has decreased. Our school must and will continue to provide all infant children with a free school meal, but we need your help to maintain our funding for next financial year.

Our next census day is Thursday 16 May 2024 and there will be an Italian themed meal, cooked freshly on site by our catering providers Orian.
