
Music Evening

Year 3 – activities will take place between 9:00am and 10:15am

Year 4 – activities will take place between 10:30am and 11:45am

Year 5 – activities will take place between 1:00pm and 2:00pm

Year 6 - activities will take place between 2:00pm and 3:00pm

Please send children to school in their outdoor PE kits with a sun hat and water bottle. We strongly advise that you apply high factor, long lasting sun protection cream before they come to school to ensure that their skin is properly protected in the event of sunny weather.

If you would like to watch your child's Sports Day events please make your way to the school field, via the main drive, no more than fifteen minutes before their class time slot.

School Gates and Road Crossing Arrangements
