## New Intake Taster Day - Friday 28th June 2024

We are really looking forward to welcoming Year 6 pupils to the New Intake Taster Day. This is the first step towards an exciting future here at Golborne High School and an opportunity to meet staff and new friends.

The staff at Golborne are looking forward to meeting the new pupils and have prepared exciting activities for the day.

Your child will need to arrive at Golborne High at **8.30am** and report to the Arts' Theatre which is accessed from the front staff car park. Please be mindful of local residents.

One of the areas that we would like to develop on the day is independence so allowing pupils to make their own way to school would be a good way to do this and will also ease congestion in the surrounding area and prepare the pupils well for September.

Pupils should wear their primary school uniform and bring their PE kit. After a general introduction, pupils will experience lessons, have a morning break and lunch and meet their new Head of House and Tutor group.

Please ensure that your child brings £2.50 on the day or a packed lunch. If you have indicated on the form previously posted out, that your child is entitled to and wishes to have a free school meal this will be provided.

The day will end at 2.35pm. Pupils will leave from the Waterworks Lane exit. This year we are unable to allow parents on site to pick pupils up.

Please make arrangements for pupils to make their own way home or to be collected at a point further away from school by yourselves. If they wish to walk home with their sibling, who is a Golborne pupil, please can arrangements be made to meet with them away from this exit to avoid congestion in the area.
