Dear parents of children currently in Years 4 and 5 at Lowton St Luke's

I would like to invite you to meet with me on *Thursday 20th June at 3.15 pm* at Lowton St Luke's to talk about secondary school.

We had a very successful inspection in March 2023 reporting on our 'transformative improvement' and judging us as 'Good in all areas'.

We have had a further external review this year, not by Ofsted, reflecting that we have moved on further in the last year.
