For those of you who knew Zak, I encourage you to remember and celebrate his vibrant life. He was a lively character, full of spirit, whose greatest joy came from playing football. His enthusiasm was infectious, and he touched the hearts of many within our school community.

For those who may not have been acquainted with Zak, we kindly ask for your understanding and respect as we navigate through our collective sorrow. It is essential for us as a school to come together and maintain a sense of normality, supporting all our pupils and staff through this challenging period.

The death of a young person is an incredibly hard reality for all of us to confront. Therefore, our school's pastoral care, alongside members of our local church and the Wigan Family Welfare Service, are dedicated to providing counselling and support for all pupils, particularly those in Year Five, as well as our staff. We also extend this support to any parents or carers who may need it.
