Please provide a statement about why you would like to become a governor in no more than 300 words. The statement should include:

- Evidence of the extent to which you possess the skills and experience the governing board desires
- Your commitment to undertake training and participate in the development of the governing board.
- How you plan to contribute to the work of the governing board or if seeking re-appointment how you have contributed to governance during your term of office

If there are more nominations than vacancies, an election will be held with a closing date of 12 noon on Tuesday 25 February 2025. All parents will be sent a voting paper with your name and statement and be asked to vote.

To qualify to become a School Governor under The School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012 you must be able to answer yes to all these statements:

 annulled or reduced:
- 2. I am not subject to a disqualification order or disqualification undertaking under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986, a disqualification order under Part 2 of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1989, a disqualification undertaking accepted under the Company Directors Disqualification (Northern Ireland) Order 2002, or an order made under section 429(2)(b) of the Insolvency Act 1986 (failure to pay under county court administration order);
- 3. I have not been removed from the office of charity trustee or trustee for a charity by the Charity Commission or Commissioners or High Court on grounds of any misconduct or mismanagement, or under section 34 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 from being concerned in the management or control of any body;
- **4.** I am not included in the list of teachers or workers considered by the Secretary of State as unsuitable to work with children or young people;
- **5.** I am not barred from any regulated activity relating to children;
- **6.** I am not disqualified from working with children or from registering for childminding or providing day care;
- 7. I am not disqualified from being an independent school proprietor, teacher or employee by the Secretary of State;
