All parents, grandparents and carers of Reception class children are welcome to attend this special event.

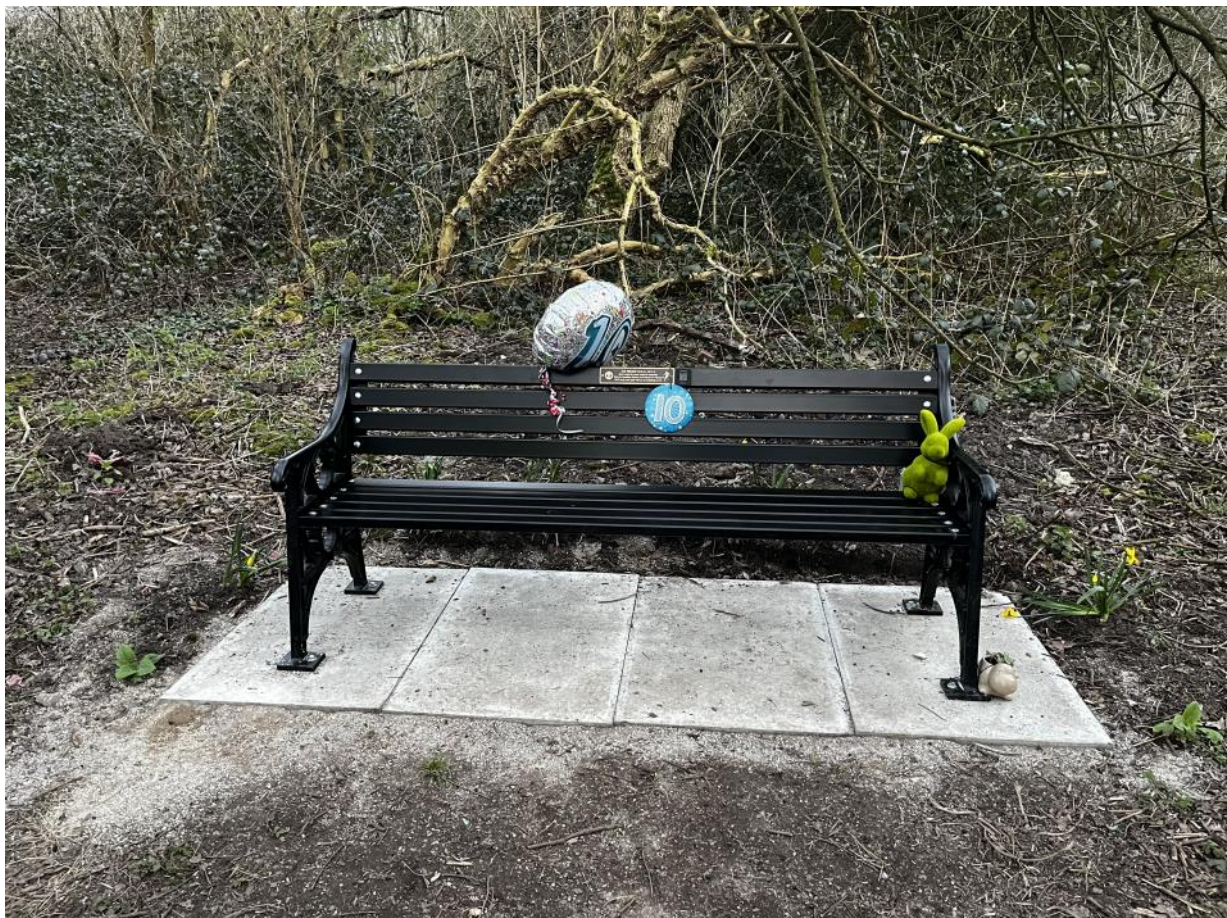
## Comic Relief

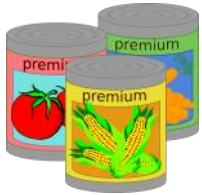


# St Luke's Church

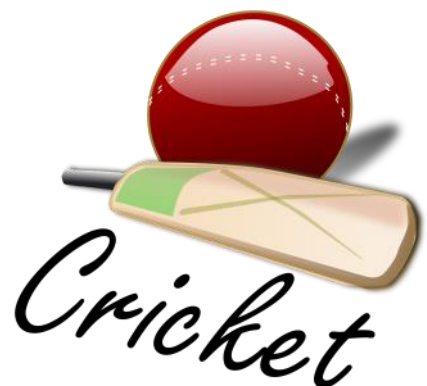


## Golborne All Stars Cricket Club
