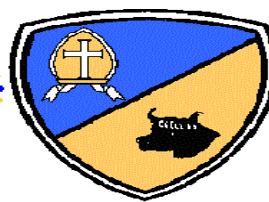

Dear Parents and Carers of Reception Class,

I hope that you and your families are well and safe during this difficult period. Thank you for self-isolating your children and supporting our national fight against the Covid-19 virus.

Mrs Richardson will contact you on Monday through Class DOJO to provide you with access details for the class distance learning material. If you have not already done so please would you complete and submit our online distance learning and GDPR agreements as soon as possible, as without this we are unable to provide you with access to the resources http://www.saintlukes.wigan.sch.uk/serve_file/787555 If you experience any difficulty accessing the material or you require help with any of the activities please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Richardson via Class DOJO, or email the school at enquiries@admin.saintlukes.wigan.sch.uk

Unfortunately and regrettably, due to the need for the specialist Reception staff to self-isolate and in order to maintain the other class bubbles in school, we will not be able to open the class to the few children who were not in school before half term. I realise that this is frustrating to you, as well as myself and my staff, but the decision has been made in the interests of all the children and staff. This means that all Reception children should work through the distance learning material and return to school on Monday 9 November 2020, providing they are well.

As you are aware, Intrahealth are due to administer the national flu vaccination programme on 4 November 2020. They have informed us that, as Reception will not be in school, they will hold a catch-up session for the children in Reception later on this term. Vaccinations will still take place for all other year groups that are in school on 4 November.

Please can I request that if, during your child's self-isolation period, they receive a positive Covid-19 test result, you inform the school by emailing enquiries@admin.saintlukes.wigan.sch.uk to enable us to fulfil our responsibility of reporting cases to Public Health.
